[A] **10:00 – 11:00** **APPROACH TO WWII** – **Richard Heneghan** will focus on situations that led to the start of the war in Europe and Asia.

[B] **10:00 – 11:00** **EXOTIC TALES 2** – **Ron Landry** will take you on a journey to Southern France and Normandy, a Boston prison, Switzerland, Germany, India, Arabia, Egypt, Italy, South England, South America, Hawaii, Hong Kong, Nepal and Bhutan.

[C] **10:00 – 11:00** **INTRODUCTION TO BEHAVIORAL ECONOMICS** – **Shai Robkin** introduces key concepts designed to help people make better decisions in general and avoid common pitfalls that result from instinctive human behavior. He will discuss how people use inaccurate perceptions of risk unconsciously, and incorrectly use simple procedures to reach decisions on difficult issues, the use of automatic versus controlled thinking, the role of chance and when and where not to trust experts.

[D] **10:00 – 3:00** **MAHJONG** – Bring your own Mahjong card and come play. There is no instructor for this weekly session.

[E] **11:15 – 12:15** **EVENTS THAT SHAPED AND CHANGED OUR COUNTRY** - **John Evans** will discuss many events in our country's history that have impacted our country's growth. Among topics to be considered are: The Constitutional Convention (and the Bill of Rights), Louisiana Purchase, Monroe Doctrine, Building of the First Transcontinental Railroad and the Panama Canal. We will discuss the events in an informal manner with opportunity for comments and questions.

[F] **11:15 – 12:15** **THE APOCALYPSE** - **Sue Stevens PhD.** This video course includes a discussion of issues regarding the book of Revelations: symbols and meanings; the problem of evil; the last judgment and the Antichrist and the meaning of history.

[G] **11:15 12:15** **RESCUE 2: HEROES OF THE HOLOCAUST** – **Daniel O'Lone** will continue his discussion on those courageous men and women, both Jewish and non-Jewish, who took heroic actions of resistance and rescue to save Jews from extermination during the Holocaust.
